ABBREVIATIONS

ch - Chain
sc - Single Crochet
dc - Double Crochet
rnd - Round
ea - Each
inc - Increase
dec - Decrease
rep - Repeat
FO - Finish Off
sl st - Slip Stitch
st - Stitch
CA - Color A (ornament)
CB - Color B (top)

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SUPPLIES

- Stuffing
- Yarn needle for finishing
- Rhinestones, Beads, or something to decorate the ornament with

- Yarn: Patons Brilliant (CA) with Size D crochet hook
- DMC Metallic Embroidery Floss (CB) with Size 1.50mm crochet hook

ORNAMENT

With CA, ch 2. 6 sc in second ch from hook (6)

rnd 1: 1 sc in ea (6)

rnd 2: 2 sc in ea (12)

rnd 3: 1 sc in ea (12)

rnd 4: (1 sc, inc) rep around (18)

rnd 5: 1 sc in ea (18)

rnd 6: (2 sc, inc) rep around (24)

rnd 7: (3 sc, inc) rep around (30)

rnd 8: (4 sc, inc) rep around (36)

rnd 9: (5 sc, inc) rep around (42)

rnds 10-15 (6 rnds): 1 sc in ea (42)

rnd 16: (5 sc, dec) rep around (36)

rnd 17: 1 sc in ea (36)

rnd 18: (4 sc, dec) rep around (30)

rnd 19: (3 sc, dec) rep around (24)

rnd 20: (2 sc, dec) rep around (18)

rnd 21: (1 sc, dec) rep around (12)

stuff

rnd 22: 1 dec in ea (6)

FO

INSTRUCTIONS

This pattern is worked in rounds. Do not join at the end of rounds. You'll probably want to use a stitch marker to mark your rounds. Gauge is not important but remember to keep your stitches tight.

This pattern was designed using Patons Brilliant for the ornament and DMC Metallic Embroidery Floss for the top. However, it can be made using ANY yarn you wish! Be sure to adjust your hook size accordingly so that your stitches are as tight as possible. The embroidery floss can be substituted with size 10 crochet thread.



TOP

Leave a one foot long tail (you'll use this later to make a loop to hang it from)

With CB, ch 2. 6 sc in second ch from hook (6)

rnd 1: 1 sc in ea (6)

rnd 2: 2 sc in ea (12)

rnd 3: ([1 dc, ch 3 and sl st in third ch from hook (picot), 1 dc] in one st, sc in next st) rep around. You will have 6 points.

FO leaving enough thread to attach it to the ornament.

Loop: Pull the tail from the beginning through the hole in the center. ch 8. Pull end into center hole, secure and FO.

Assembly: Using a needle and the thread you left, attach the top to the ornament by making a stitch at each of the points on the top piece. FO.
